ANNOUNCING Our Fall harvest program for children ages 3 to 8 years old. At Gro-Moore Farms children will learn and have fun at the same time.

ACTIVITIES Inside our market and greenhouse, we play a game with fruits and vegetables and venture through our straw crawl maze. Outside we visit our goat hotel, where children can pet and feed the goats. There is a fun house, the ABC maze and a pumpkin slide. We also have our John Deere train ride. Children can pick out a pie size pumpkin, plus have a snack of cider and a cookie. Coloring sheets for each child will be given to teachers. Class pumpkins are available at an additional charge.

WHERE 2811 East Henrietta Road, Henrietta, NY 14467. We are located in front of the Dome Arena. Take 390 to exit 14 (East Henrietta Road which is also 15A). Go South. Gro-Moore Farms will be on the right just past Calkins Road.

COST PER CHILD \$5.00 per child which includes everything. For groups with less than 10 children, there is a \$50.00 minimum fee. For other children attending with chaperones, there is a \$5.00 fee. There is no fee for teachers and chaperones for the tour. They may purchase pumpkins, etc. inside the market.

AVAILABLE DATES Weekdays starting September 29th through October 31st (excluding Columbus Day) from 8:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The last two weeks of October are extremely busy, so if possible, try to reserve a date earlier in the month.

LENGTH OF TOUR Please allow an hour for the program and another 15 minutes for snack. If you do not have enough time for your snack, please let us know and we will have it ready for you to take back to your classroom.

RESERVATIONS REQUIRED Please contact Brenda Moore at (585)370-6138 to reserve a date and time for your field trip. Please have children ready to start your tour at the reserved time. If you are meeting at Gro-Moore Farms, please arrive 15 minutes earlier than scheduled. If on the day of your field trip you need to cancel or are going to be late, please call 370-6138 or 359-3310.

SUGGESTIONS FOR THE DAY OF YOUR FIELD TRIP Make sure children are dressed for the weather. We usually proceed with tours in the rain or snow. Please bring hand wipes as they are very useful. We are trying to recycle, so please bring a plastic bag for each child with their name on it for their pumpkin. Name tags are also helpful.
